Teaching:

3. Pictures of God's Kindness (Hos 14:4-7)
4. The importance of submitting to God's Word (Hos. 14:9)

Discussion

1. Hosea 13:7–8 describes God using the imagery of a lion, leopard, and bear. What do you learn about God's character based on those descriptions? (Question 3, Unleashing the Text)
2. What obstacles hinder you from experiencing the full spectrum of God's love? What are some important truths to remember as you deal with these obstacles? (Adapted from Question 7, Reflecting on the Text)
3. Look at Hosea's epilogue in 14:9. What does it look like for someone to "walk" correctly in light of the principles Hosea shared and the problems he exposed? (Question 8, Reflecting on the Text)
